EU Regulation EC 1907/2006; Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) published Candidate Lists.

On 16/07/2019 (DD/MM/Year) the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) added four new substances to the Candidate List due to their toxicity to reproduction, endocrine disruption and a combination of other properties of concern. The latter causes probable serious effects to human health and the environment, giving rise to an equivalent level of concern to carcinogenic, mutagenic and reprotoxic (CMR), persistent, bio-accumulative and toxic (PBT) and very persistent and very bio-accumulative (vPvB) substances, respectively.

Elgiloy Specialty Metals, a division of Combined Metals of Chicago L.L.C., has reviewed our current operations and does not knowingly add to the product or processes used to produce parts, any of the substances included on the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) at a level greater than 0.1% by weight.
