## Customer EPCRA Notification for Reporting Year 2020

Section 313 of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986 (EPCRA) requires certain facilities that manufacture, process, or otherwise use listed toxic chemicals to report the annual quantity of such chemicals entering each environmental medium. EPCRA Section 313 is also known as the Toxic Release Inventory (TRI).
