We are dedicated to working with our customers and suppliers to meet consumer product safety requirements applicable to our products, including California Proposition 65, officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986.

CMC/ESM offers custom precision rolling and slitting of nickel, cobalt, titanium, and stainless-steel alloys. CMC-Bellwood is a stainless-steel service center processing stainless steel strip, slit coil, blanks, and special sheet products. The service center also provides coil buffing and polishing, stamping, punching, and cut-to-length services for specialty coil products.

These alloys do not present a risk to human health and the environment under California's Proposition 65. The key metals of interest for Prop with regard to specialty steels are nickel and chromium. Chromium is listed in the hexavalent form which is not found in stainless-steel. Prop 65 cancer listing for nickel compounds does not include nickel alloys.
