Appendix 1 – Terms and conditions of Approval

1. The Air Prestwick Quality team must be notified immediately of any proposed significant changes that will affect your NADCAP, UKAS, AS/EN9100 or ISO approval. Also included are any changes to Company name, location of premises Managing Director or Accountable Manager, Quality Manager, other key personnel or facilities affecting product quality or special processes. BAE Systems reserves the right to review continuance of approval as a result of any such changes.
2. Periodic reviews of your Management System, Product(s) and/ or Process (es), and those of your approved suppliers, may be undertaken by authorised representatives of BAE Systems Air Prestwick who will require access to your, and your suppliers premises at all reasonable times. (This access shall also be extended to our regulatory authorities). We may additionally direct that reviews addressing specific areas of activity be undertaken when we consider circumstances so warrant. Non disclosure agreements may apply.
3. All suppliers to BAE Systems Air Prestwick shall have their own Alerts and Recalls process that identifies what actions are required when notifying us, or our approved suppliers to whom you sell material, about suspect or non-conforming material. This shall be notified to within 72 hours of the incident being highlighted along with supporting evidence available. Full details and further supporting evidence shall be supplied as it becomes available.
4. Test Reports and supporting data for the initial and batch mix covering composition and mechanical testing, shall be retained in accordance with the requirements of EN9130 and shall be made available upon request and in all cases, provided with the C of C releasing the material per clause 6.
5. Material composition and mechanical properties shall be designed to Material Specifications based upon recognised British or International Standards or BAE Material Specifications.
6. The raw material producer shall assure conformance to the applicable material specification by issuing a Certificate of Conformity declaring same and by providing a Test Report/Certificate to demonstrate compliance via recorded data confirming composition and mechanical properties.
7. Testing shall be conducted using approved methods and equipment traceable to recognised British or International Standards as stated in the applicable Material Specification.
8. Heat Treatment, Solution Treatment or Processing operations, e.g. Stretching, Rolling, Extrusions, Forged Plate, shall be performed in a way to ensure the final material properties meet the requirements of the applicable Material Specification in accordance with your own proprietary process methods unless specified procedures are quoted in the Material Specification.
9. The Scope of this approval is all materials stated in our approved supplier's Purchase Order in conjunction with the general description contained in your AS/EN9100/ISO/NADCAP/UKAS approval AS9100D and ISO9001:2015 certificate 58720 & NADCAP.
10. Your BAE Systems Supplier Approval requires that your 3rd party external regulatory certificates are continuously in approval. If any approval expires, you must inform BAE Systems Air Prestwick to assess impact to existing scope of Subcontractor approvals. Updates to 3rd Party external regulatory certificates should be supplied to BAE Systems Air Prestwick for assessment / record keeping.
